Internship Description:

The Religious Freedom Institute's (RFI) Internship and Research Assistant programs provide an opportunity for individuals to learn, grow, and contribute to efforts to advance religious freedom for everyone, everywhere. During the internship program, students will participate in the work of the Religious Freedom Institute through its research, education, and policy programs, and gain experience in promoting religious freedom in the United States and around the world. Housed in RFI's National Center for Religious Freedom Education, the internship program allows students to explore key issues and areas of strategic interest (geographic or thematic) through work with one of RFI's Action Teams.

Internship Features: As an RFI Intern or Research Assistant, you will:

- Conduct research alongside some of the world's leading religious freedom scholars
- Collaborate with congressional offices, executive agencies, and other DC-based non-profits
- Support the work of RFI's leadership team and program staff with research, writing, and program management
- Assist in communications and digital media tasks, including drafting, reviewing, editing, and publishing of articles, reports, blog contributions, and social media posts
- Assist with logistical and administrative tasks related to events and other organizational activities

**Undergraduate students are eligible for the Internship and graduate students are eligible for the Research Assistant program.*
