The program provides a flexible and cost-effective way to hire new employees, gives you longer-term experience with a student where he/she develops over time in the role, and provides you access to top students receiving additional career coaching and training prior to working with you. Your involvement in ELEVATE will create tangible opportunities for students to combine their classroom education, where they are learning about the value and dignity of work, with meaningful work experience, where they can apply what they learn in your organization.

OUALIFICATIONS: WHAT YOUR WORK OPPORTUNITY PROVIDES ——

- **Meaningful Work Experience:** Students contribute to business goals, positions offer genuine usefulness to your company with strong learning components for the student employee
- Supervisor Support: Students receive training and support from a dedicated supervisor
- Performance Reviews: Supervisors provide consistent professional feedback for student improvement and career development
- Paid: Employer offers at least minimum wage for duration of employment
- Extended Contract: Contract length: 4, 8, or 12 months (with opportunity for extensions)

GUIDING PRINCIPLES

EMPLOYERS —

- Select contract length & offer options for full-time, part-time, or flexible work schedules, with inperson and/or remote work
- Receive a personal point of contact to expand brand awareness across campus, attract top students, and match with qualified candidates
- Interview candidates that match needs
- Design a contract that includes payment and performance evaluation
- Select Start date: August, January, and/or May

STUDENTS—

- Complete career preparation workshops before the beginning ELEVATE Experience
